MEMORANDUM OF INSTRUCTION (MOI) **AND TOURNAMENT RULES**

1. **GENERAL:** The 2004 Army Europe Golfing Championships will be conducted at Heidelberg Golf Course at Oftersheim, Germany on 20-22 July 2004. This championship event will be conducted IAW USGA and Heidelberg Golf Course rules and is open to all authorized military and civilian US ID card holders stationed or TDY in USEUCOM.

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The following special eligibility criteria apply to this year's event:

a. Tournament is open to all Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard military personnel on active duty; and, Reserves and/or National Guard military personnel who are TDY in this command. Military personnel competing in this tournament may use results from this tournament as part of their individual application and resume for consideration for selection to compete in the All-Army Golf Trials (next scheduled at Fort Carson, Colorado in Sep 04).

b. Civilian employees and family members of military personnel listed in 2a above who are 18 years of age or older (as of 20 Jul 04) are eligible to participate in this tournament.

c. Open Division participants must possess a current USGA handicap of 15 or better - Seniors and Women's Division handicap may be higher.

d. Non-US ID card personnel are not eligible to compete in this championship event.

3. **ENTRY FEE:** Individual entry fee for this year's golf championships is \$35.00 per golfer.

4. **COMPETITION:** The 2004 Army Europe Golf Championships will consist of 54 holes of stroke play; 18 holes tournament play for each day of the 3-day event.

a. A practice round will be available to all entrants on the 19 of July. Tee times will be determined by number of entries – contestants may call the Clubhouse for tee-times on 19th July.

b. USGA rules will apply except when governed by local rules. Rules sheets will be handed out on the first day of practice to all participating golfers.

c. No carts allowed (exception permitted only with doctors' note).

d. All competitors will be required to provide their own personal equipment and clubs.

e. Competitors will play the ball as it lies throughout this tournament.

MOI & TOURNAMENT RULES (CONT'D):

5. **SCHEDULING:** Tee-times will be determined based on number of entries.

a. All golfers are requested to check starting times in the Clubhouse as the Play will be on a shotgun schedule the first two days.

b. All players may golf the final day, however, only players within 20 strokes of the leading score will be permitted to actually compete for the 2004 championships.

c. Tee times for the third (final) day will be determined by number of players who survive the cut and the number of those who don't qualify, but choose to play the final day.

d. Golfers are requested to please excuse themselves personally if they wish not to play the final day.

e. Tournament Manager will post scheduled starting times the evening (after second day's play) before the final third days competition.

6. **AWARDS:** Championships awards will be awarded to the top three finishers in each of the following three divisions:

(1) **Men's Open Division** – all ages.

(2) **Men's Senior Division** – 55 years or older. **(NOTE: Players entering the Senior' Division will be allowed to compete in the Seniors Division only).**

(3) **Women's Division** – all ages.

7. **LUNCHEON AND AWARDS BANQUET.** A luncheon and awards banquet will be held at 1400 on 22 Jul for command representatives to present 2004 Championship awards. Players and guests are invited to attend the conclusion of this year's golfing event.

8. **BILLETING:** Military and Civilian Lodging accommodations are available in Heidelberg by calling 388-9387. Arrangements have also been made for Golfers desiring to park Camping Trailers to do so at the Heidelberg Rod & Gun Club adjacent to the Heidelberg Golf Course. Special arrangements for Trailer space parking should be made in advance with the Heidelberg Rod & Gun Club Manager by calling 06202-51193.

9. **TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT:** The 2004 Army Europe Tournament Manager is Mr. Mike Falk, Manager Heidelberg Golf Course. The tournament committee is Mr. John Allred, IMA-E MWR Staff Officer and Mr. Mike O'Donnell, DCA, 411th BSB. The Tournament Manager and Committee will rule on any dispute(s) and/or infractions during the tournament.
